BC Timber Sales (BCTS) is self-financing program within the Ministry of Forests, Lands, Natural Resource Operations and Rural Development, BCTS manages the sustainable harvesting and reforestation of approximately 20 per cent of the timber available for harvest from British Columbia's timber harvesting land base. Working at BCTS is an opportunity to positively impact B.C.'s economy, forests, communities and residents. We have over 650 staff in 33 communities throughout the province and offer a wide variety of career opportunities that include positions in professional forestry, forest technology, Graphic Information Systems (GIS) and business administration; areas of specialization include mapping, data analysis, seedling services, certification standards, tenure and harvest operations, reforestation and sustainability.



Conifex Timber Inc.

Conifex's business is the harvesting of timber and the manufacture and sale of lumber, primarily for North American and Asian markets. Our sawmills process high-quality SPF logs into higher-grade and commodity-grade dimensional lumber.

Residuals from our manufacturing process create a number of byproducts which are sold to local customers; wood chips primarily used for pulp production, and sawdust, shavings, and bark that are sold to wood pellet manufacturers, finger joint lumber plants, mulch and soil production businesses and biomass power plants.

We believe that efficient utilization of our timber resources is essential. Our timberland operations in Canada seek to supply our sawmills with low-cost fibre, and enable efficient manufacture of lumber that meets customer needs, and optimizes all opportunities to generate the widest possible profit margins.
