First Nations, Inuit and Métis peoples.^[1]

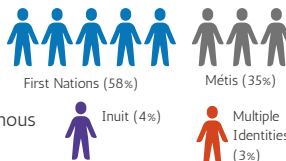


Over **1.1 million** live in or **Indigenous peoples** near forests

about 9% of forest sector workers in Canada's forest-reliant communities are Indigenous peoples ^[2]

in Canada identify themselves as Indigenous



1 in 6 Indigenous are in ages 15-24.

This is a key reason why the Indigenous population in Canada is expected to grow quickly in the next few decades.^[4]
